Gay Vancouver Pageant

The Imperial Sovereign Court of the Raintree Empire (ISCRE) produces the annual Gay Vancouver Pageant at which contestants vie for the titles of Mr., Miss, Ms., and Mx. Gay Vancouver. This year's pageant will be held at 5pm on Saturday July 12th at Martha's Pantry, 1220 NE 68th ST. Tickets will be available for \$25. A portion of the net proceeds will benefit Martha's Pantry, The Audria M. Edwards, Pride of the Rose, and Queer Youth Resource Center.

Required Qualifications

To apply for the titles, applicants must (1) be at least 21 years of age, (2) have lived in the Empire (Clark, Cowlitz, Skamania, Wahkiakum, Pacific, or Lewis Counties) for at least six months, (3) be Registered Members of the ISCRE, (4) have completed and submitted the attached form, and (5) have paid the \$50.00 application fee.

Screening, Campaigning, and Election

- Application forms and fees can be mailed to the ISCRE (2512 E. Evergreen Blvd. #55 Vancouver, WA 98661) or delivered to the ISCRE's Treasurer (David) by 6:15pm on Wednesday June 25th.
- Applicants will be interviewed by members of the Board of Directors and the College of Monarchs beginning at 6:30pm Wednesday June 25th at Martha's Pantry. Contestants will be announced after all interviews have been completed. Application fees of individuals who are not selected as contestants will be refunded at that time.
- Contestants may campaign from the time they are announced until the polls open at the Pageant. Rules for campaigning will be described after contestants are announced.
- Contestants must attend and be prepared to be introduced, answer a question, and perform on stage during the Pageant.
- Voting will take place after all contestants have been introduced at the Pageant. To be eligible to vote, individuals must be at least 21 years of age and provide proof of residency in the Empire or be Honored Members of the ISCRE.
- The contestant for each title who obtains the highest number of votes will take the oath of office, be invested with the title, and receive a symbol of office at the end of the Pageant. A contestant who has no opponent must receive votes on more than half of the ballots cast.

Responsibilities of Gay Vancouver Title Holders

- Attend Gay Pageants in at least three cities outside the Empire, at least six meetings of the ISCRE Board of Directors, the majority of ISCRE-sponsored fund-raising events, and the ISCRE's Coronation in 2026.
- Help plan and produce at least one fund-raising event and the Gay Vancouver Pageant in 2026.
- Remain a resident of the Empire. (Title holders who live outside the Empire for more than 30 consecutive days in the first nine months of their term of office must vacate their titles.)
